Instructions for use

Spray in an even coat on skin, being careful not to cause dripping with excessive amounts of product.

Spray lightly over non-treated clothing, to help avoid bites through the fabric.

Use in conjunction with permethrin-treated clothing for maximum protection.

Apply more frequently in humid climates where perspiration can wash off repellent.

In such a climate, 75 ml will last approximately 2 weeks (3 weeks in drier climates).
